Kaplan Admission Test

The Kaplan Admission Test will be administered on the following dates in E-150:

Friday, January 26th @ 9:00 am

Friday, February 2nd @ 1:00 pm

Friday, February 9th @ 9:00 am

Friday, February 16th @ 1:00 pm

Friday, February 23rd @ 9:00 am AND 1:00 pm

Snow make-up day only – Saturday, February 24 @ 9:00am

How to apply and register for the Kaplan Admission Test:

The Associate Degree Nursing Program at Piedmont Community College uses the Kaplan Admission Test to aid in selecting candidates for the upcoming Nursing Class. Upon completion of ALL developmental courses, students may apply to take the Kaplan Admission Test. The test cannot be taken until PHASE I of the ADN Admissions process is completed and all required materials have been received in the Admissions Office.

Students are only allowed to test once per academic year. Students who achieve an overall score of 65% will be given priority admission over those scoring lower than 65% due to these score correlating with a student successfully completing the nursing program. It is the student's responsibility to complete the application to test and schedule a date to take the test prior to the last scheduled day of testing. **Applicants who qualify for testing accommodations, must request accommodation and notify the testing proctor prior to taking the test.**

In order to reserve a seat for the Kaplan Admission Test on one of the above dates, you must meet with a nursing advisor to obtain signature on the Kaplan Information and Application, pay your testing fee in A Building and contact the Student Development Office in E Building to sign up for the test. **There is a \$25 fee for taking the test.** Seating for each exam is limited. Your seat will not be guaranteed until payment is received. **If you miss the exam for any reason, your money is non-refundable. In the event that bad weather forces a test day to cancel, the snow make-up day is the reserved date.**

In order to take the test on this date, you must arrive at the testing location no later than 15 minutes before the appointed time. Absolutely no one will be admitted after testing has started.

On the day of the exam, you must bring the following:

1. Two forms of Identification. **One form must be a Photo ID.** This can be a driver's license, valid passport, or school picture ID. *(Students who fail to present two forms of identification as described above will not be admitted into the testing room.)*
2. At least two No. 2 pencils.

You will need to allow a minimum of 3 hours for taking the test, printing of the score reports, and checking out. Study guides for the Kaplan Admission Test may be checked out from our library or purchased through the PCC Bookstore or other location.
