How to apply and register for the KNAT:

The Associate Degree Nursing Program at Piedmont Community College uses the KNAT to aid in selecting candidates for the upcoming Nursing Class. The KNAT cannot be taken until PHASE I of the ADN Admissions process is completed and all required materials have been received in the Admissions Office.

Students are only allowed to test once per academic year. Students who achieve an overall score of 67% will be given priority admission over those scoring lower than 67% due to these score correlating with a student successfully completing the nursing program. It is the student's responsibility to complete the application to test and schedule a date to take the test prior to the last scheduled day of testing. **Applicants who qualify for testing accommodations, must request accommodation and notify the testing proctor prior to taking the test.**

In order to reserve a seat for the Kaplan Admission Test on one of the above dates, you must meet with a nursing advisor to obtain signature on the Kaplan Information and Application, pay your testing fee in A Building and sign up for the test with the Director of Nursing or designee. There is a \$25 fee for taking the test. Seating for each exam is limited. If you miss the exam for any reason, your money is non-refundable. In the event that bad weather forces a test day to cancel, the snow make-up day is the reserved date.

On the testing day, you are encouraged to arrive at the testing location 15 minutes before the appointed time. Students will not be admitted after test has started. Please bring the following:

1. Two forms of Identification. **One form must be a Photo ID.** This can be a driver's license, valid passport, or school picture ID. *(Students who fail to present two forms of identification as described above will not be admitted into the testing room.)*
2. At least two No. 2 pencils.

You will need to allow a minimum of 3 hours for taking the test. **The study guide for the KNAT, Nursing School Entrance Exams Prep 2019-2020, may be purchased in the PCC bookstore or online.** For questions about test administration or registration for the KNAT, please contact the Director of Nursing in Building L. In case of inclement weather, the Kaplan Admission Test will follow the College's hours of operation.

KNAT Information and Application

The KNAT is mandatory for entrance into the Nursing Program. This test is a computerized admissions test used by Piedmont Community College to measure basic skills in reading, math, english, science and critical thinking. The KNAT is a 91-question, multiple-choice test that evaluates the basic skills of students seeking entry into a nursing program leading to RN licensure. A The study guide for the KNAT, Nursing School Entrance Exams Prep 2019-2020, may be purchased in the PCC bookstore or online.

Payment of Fees

Please meet with a nursing advisor to confirm that you have met the requirements and are eligible to take the KNAT. All students taking the KNAT at Piedmont Community College must pay \$25.00. Prior to registering for the exam, please take the payment to the Cashier's Office. Once you have paid your fee, you must schedule your exam date with the Director of Nursing or designee.

You will not be allowed to test without two forms of identification.
