Funds are available for students enrolled in the programs listed below to help those who do not qualify for federal Pell grants, but demonstrate financial need. Up to \$750 per semester may be awarded for curriculum programs and up to \$300 for continuing education programs.

- To qualify, curriculum students must fill out the 2019-2020 FAFSA
- The Federal TRIO Programs Current-Year Low-Income Levels for 2019 will be used to determine Continuing Education student's eligibility
