### How to Apply and Register for the KNAT:

The Associate Degree Nursing Program at Piedmont Community College uses the KNAT to aid in selecting candidates for the upcoming Nursing Class. The KNAT cannot be taken until PHASE I of the ADN Admissions process is completed and all required materials have been received in the Admissions Office.

**Students are only allowed to test once per academic year. Students who achieve an overall score of 67% will be given priority admission over those scoring lower than 67% due to these scores correlating with a student successfully completing the Nursing program.** It is the student's responsibility to complete the application to test and schedule a date to take the test prior to the last scheduled day of testing. *Applicants who qualify for testing accommodations, must request accommodations from the PCC Student Development Office, and notify the testing proctor prior to taking the test.*

To reserve a date and time to take the KNAT on one of the above dates, you must first consult with a Nursing Advisor to ensure that you are eligible to take the test. Once approved, complete the KNAT Application, pay the \$30 testing fee in Building A on the Person County campus or call 336-322-2125 to pay via telephone. Once you have paid and received a signature on the Application or confirmation email from the Business Office, you may sign up for the KNAT with the Director of Nursing or designee by call 336-322-2219. Seating capacity for each test is limited. If you miss the test for any reason, your testing fee is non-refundable. If inclement weather forces a scheduled test day to be cancelled, a make-up day will be arranged.

You will be notified via email of the testing location prior to your scheduled date and time. On testing day, you are encouraged to arrive at the testing location at least 15 minutes before the scheduled time to get checked in and have your identification verified. Students will not be admitted after test has started. Please bring the following:

1. Two forms of Identification. **One form must be a Photo ID.** This can be a driver's license, valid passport, or school picture ID. The second can be a debit/credit card, Social Security card, etc. *(Students who fail to present two matching forms of identification as described above will not be admitted into the testing room.)*
2. A pen or pencil *(Scrap paper will be provided.)*

You should allow a minimum of three hours for taking the test. A study guide for the KNAT, "Nursing School Entrance Exams Prep 2021-2022", may be purchased in the PCC bookstore or online. For questions about test administration or registration for the KNAT, please contact the Director of Nursing in L-108 on the Person County Campus or by calling 336-322-2219. In case of inclement weather, the test will follow the College's hours of operation.

# Kaplan Nursing Admissions Test Information and Application

The KNAT is mandatory for entrance into the Piedmont Community College (PCC) Nursing program. This test is a computerized admissions tool used to measure basic reading, math, english, science and critical thinking proficiencies. The KNAT is a 91-question, multiple-choice test that evaluates the basic skills of students seeking entry into a Nursing program leading to RN licensure. A study guide for the KNAT, "Nursing School Entrance Exams Prep 2021-2022", may be purchased in the PCC bookstore or from numerous online sites (*such as Amazon, Walmart, Target, etc.*).

## Payment of Fees

Candidates must consult with a Nursing Advisor to confirm that they have met the requirements and are eligible to take the KNAT. All students taking the KNAT at PCC must pay a \$30.00 testing fee. Prior to registering for the exam, please take the payment to the Cashier's Office on the Person County Campus or by calling the Business Office at 336-322-2125. Once you have paid the testing fee, you must schedule your exam date and time with the Director of Nursing or designee by calling 336-322-2219.

**You will not be allowed to test without TWO forms of identification.**
