

CASWELL COUNTY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION 2023

Each year, Caswell County Farm Bureau will award one college scholarship, up to \$1,000 in value, to a qualified applicant if our financial position permits.

OBJECTIVE

Provide financial assistance for applicant seeking higher education. First consideration will be given, but not limited to Agricultural, Health Occupational or Educational career courses of study and Caswell County Farm Bureau members. The qualification will be determined at the sole discretion of the Caswell County Board of Directors.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. High school senior from the current school year.
2. Candidate for scholarship must have maintained a cumulative 2.5 or better average during their high school career.
3. Provide (2) recommendations from non- relatives.
4. Candidate must provide SAT scores. Transcript of high school record and current photograph.
5. Candidate must be available for interview by the Caswell County Farm Bureau Scholarship committee if requested.
6. Deadline for applications will be May 15, 2023 submitted by the applicant at the Caswell County Farm Bureau office.

INSTITUTION

Scholarship shall be applicable to college, university or technical college of recipient's choice.

TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP

1. One scholarship, up to \$1,000 in value, to be awarded by the Caswell County Farm Bureau.
2. The scholarship will be non-renewable.
3. The amount of the scholarship will be paid directly to the College, University or Technical school of the recipient's choice.
4. Recipient must be accepted as a full-time student for the coming academic year beginning with the fall semester.

BASIS OF AWARD

Factors considered in granting the scholarship may include, but are not limited to:

1. Character
2. Moral standards
3. Citizenship
4. Past and present academic performance
5. Appropriate recommendations
6. Statement of Career goals
7. Financial need
8. Extracurricular activities

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Board of Directors of Caswell County Farm Bureau will determine through the process outlined above, each year's scholarship recipient. Caswell County Farm Bureau also reserves the right not to present the annual scholarship if qualified applicants are not found.
