Qualifications for receiving scholarship:

- Must be a Caswell County Resident/ Caswell County High School Student.
- Must be attending an institution of higher education (2 or 4 Year institution)

- Completed Caswell County Cattlemen's Association Application
- Copy of College Acceptance Letter that the Applicant is Planning to Attend
- Official High School Transcripts
- 3 Letters of Recommendation (2 Teacher, 1 Community Member)
- Photo of Applicant (Emailed/Brought in with Application)
- Financial Need Statement (**Optional & Confidential**)

Applications will be due by **March 31st, 2023 to the Extension Office**

-Any applications received after March 31st will not be processed by the scholarship committee.

Date of Decision: April 30th, 2023. Applicant will be notified the following week. Applicants will be awarded the scholarship at the Scholarship Awards Ceremony in May or will attend the Caswell Cattlemen's Meeting in May to receive the scholarship. The scholarship money will be sent to the institution of the applicant's choice after class enrollment.

Caswell County Cattlemen's Scholarship Committee: Members, Guidelines, & Points Allocations

- Scholarship Committee Members will consist of a group of 3-4 Active Members of the Caswell County Cattlemen's Association.
- Priority will be given to applicants who reside in Caswell County regardless of race, gender, or national origin.
- Incomplete applications & late applications will not be considered in the process.

Points System for Awarding Scholarship

20 Points- Priority given to a Caswell County High School Student (Including homeschool, private school & charter school).

40 Points- Priority given to a student with an agriculture background and future.

15 Points- Given depending on school and community activities and involvement.

25 Points- Applicants must be accepted or enrolled in a college or university (2 or 4 year program) to receive the scholarship, and provide a copy of the acceptance letter.

Additional- Will NOT affect your application if not completed.

25 Points- May be awarded according to student's financial need (**Optional Section**)
