



Academic advising pre-registration conferences are happening now! Check out the FAQ below for need-to-know information about summer and fall registration.

What is the difference between pre-registration and registration?

Pre-registration occurs a few weeks before registration officially opens for the upcoming term. This is an opportunity for you to meet with your advisor, plan courses, review your program progress toward graduation, and more.

What happens during a pre-registration advising conference?

During pre-registration advising conferences, your advisor will help you load classes into your **Self-Service Course Plan**, AKA your shopping cart. Once registration officially begins, you'll be able to **Register**, AKA checkout, your classes to confirm your enrollment.

How do I register for my classes? When?

Starting **November 8th**, you'll be able to log into <u>Self-Service</u> to register for your summer and fall classes. How can I meet with my academic advisor?

Students can schedule appointments up to 2 weeks in advance on the **Pacer Advising** webpage: www.piedmontcc.edu/advising.
