3. Submit Your Transcripts

Request official transcript(s) from high school, or high school equivalency, and previous college(s). Consider sending additional information including Advanced Placement (AP), SAT, or ACT scores via College Board. This information helps determine your placement into English and math courses.

Note: Placement testing is not required for all PCC students. It is required for international students and students who are unable to satisfy the Reinforced Instruction for Student Excellence (RISE) placement criteria.

5. Schedule an Academic Advising Meeting

<u>Academic Advising</u> is one of the most critical components of student success at PCC. Advisors answer questions, provide valuable information about programs of study and guide students in setting academic goals, selecting courses and making sure they're ready for registration.

Academic Advisors meet with students every semester to assist with course planning and registration through Self-Service, aka the Student Portal.
