



Nursing Evening/Weekend Cohort

Caswell County Campus

In January 2022, Piedmont Community College (PCC) started an Evening/Weekend Associates Degree Nursing program that is primarily located on the Caswell County campus in Yanceyville, NC. The inaugural cohort graduated in December 2023 with a 100% first-time pass rate on the NCLEX!!

Additional information about the Evening/Weekend cohort:

- **Evening/Weekend cohort**
 - The first semester, students meet up to four evenings each week for lecture and labs.
 - Subsequent semesters, students meet two to three evenings each week and then may have simulation/labs throughout certain courses.
 - Clinicals generally are on Fridays or Saturdays.
 - Sundays-OFF (could change depending on clinical availability or meeting course objectives)
- **Six semesters program**
 - Next session starts Spring 2026 (*January 2026*)
 - Anticipated graduation for this cohort is Fall 2027 (*December 2027*)
- **Same Admissions policies and curriculum as the traditional PCC ADN/AGE programs**
- **Admissions Test: TEAS Test required for entry**
 - See Admissions Test Information Application for more information, including dates, times, and other requirements
- **Important Dates & Deadlines:**
 - Admissions Test administered on Person and Caswell campuses
 - **July – August 2025**
 - Numerous dates/times will be available
 - Deadline for application
 - **September 1, 2025**
 - Applications are completed by candidates when they take the Admissions Test
 - Admission Decision/Letters to Students
 - **October 15, 2025**
 - Classes Begin
 - **January 2026**
 - Graduation
 - **December 2027**
